Virginia hunt #2 was held in Chancellorsville VA March 19 & 20th. We were given permission to hunt private property adjacent to the battlefield just South-West of the Wilderness Church. The area we hunted had a huge Confederate presence with several divisions marching right over where we hunted! Some of the highlights found were dozens of dropped Confederate Gardner bullets, a beautiful 12lbs cannon ball found by Keith Debes (left), a copper bomb fuse dated 1861 found by Bob Hill (below), from VA and a bayonet found by Dennis Luria (below left), *cont'd.*

CHANCELLORSVILLE, VA—MARCH 19 & 20, 2011



Steve Scirrocco and I hit an area near the road where we found many dropped confederate bullets amongst iron. The signals were difficult because the iron was throwing them off but you knew something was there.

By Sunday afternoon, in an area maybe 10 x 20 yards (pictured left with Gary Storm), two buttons, two knapsack hooks and over 130 bullets (mostly Confederate) came out of this iron infested area. The bullets were "dropped" and not fired examples. We were most likely hunting a confederate site where they camped or rested before continuing their push.

All in all a very exciting trip with many nice Civil War relics. We look forward to more History Hunters joining us for Virginia Hunt #3 (date and place TBD).~*Carter Pennington*


After being rescheduled a few times due to the weather, the club finally was able to celebrate at Nucci's Restaurant. It was a fun evening with great food, people, raffles and fun.
